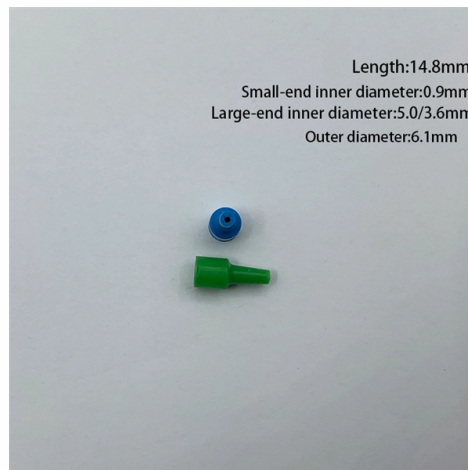

Aerial ODFs are typically weatherproof, compact, and pole-mountable, designed for high-density fiber management in outdoor conditions. Common features include:

- Modular trays for splicing and slack storage
- Cable entry and exit ports with grommets or seals for environmental protection
- Lockable enclosures to prevent unauthorized access
- Flexible capacity to accommodate varying fiber counts, from a few dozen to several hundred fibers

Some aerial ODFs are pre-terminated, allowing faster installation and reducing the risk of errors during field deployment.
