

All 4-core optical cables



AI Overview

A 4-core optical cable is a fiber optic cable containing four individual optical fibers within a single protective jacket, allowing multiple independent data transmissions.

Structure and Components

A 4-core optical cable consists of four separate optical fibers, each capable of transmitting data as light signals. These fibers are typically made of glass or plastic and are surrounded by several protective layers to ensure durability and performance:

- Core:** The central part of each fiber where light signals travel. Single-mode fibers have a core diameter of about 8–10 micrometers, while multi-mode fibers range from 50–62.5 micrometers.
- Cladding:** Surrounds the core and has a lower refractive index, reflecting light back into the core to maintain signal transmission.
- Buffer Coating:** Protects the core and cladding from physical damage and environmental factors.
- Strength Members:** Materials like aramid yarn (Kevlar) or steel wires provide tensile strength to prevent stretching or breaking.
- Outer Jacket:** The external protective layer, often made of polyethylene (PE) for outdoor use or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) for indoor safety.

Function and Applications

A 4-core optical cable can support multiple duplex links, meaning it can handle two-way communication on two separate channels or provide redundancy with backup fibers. This makes it suitable for:

- High-speed internet connections
- Telecommunications networks
- FTTH (Fiber to the Home) and GPON systems
- Data centers and cloud computing applications

Compared to a 2-core cable, a 4-core cable offers higher bandwidth, faster speeds, and redundancy, ensuring uninterrupted service even if one fiber fails.
