When moving heavy reels, use forklifts, reel movers, or cranes with spreader bars to avoid direct contact with the cable jacket and prevent crushing. Protective Measures Keep end caps and seals on all cable ends to prevent moisture ingress and contamination. Avoid excessive tension or tight loops; create large, loose loops to minimize stress and microbends. Inspect reels for damaged caps, crushed jackets, or loose connectors before storage or deployment. Label each cable clearly with type, fiber count, length, manufacturing date, and lot number for traceability and inventory management. Standards and Best Practices Follow manufacturer specifications for temperature, humidity, and tensile limits during storage and rewinding. Rotate inventory using first-in, first-out (FIFO) to prevent degradation of older stock. Avoid storing cables in harsh environments with chemic...
