Cables on poles sharing electrical and telecom/CATV cables must be installed in the telecom space with proper clearance from both electrical cables and other low voltage cables. This includes separation mid-span where both electrical cables and the messenger/fiber cables. Deploying fiber above ground on poles or towers removes the need for underground digging and is particularly useful when the ground is uneven, rocky or both. Aerial installation is generally much less costly than underground construction also. Materials and equipment should not be used for in your company's safety procedures and, if necessary, lineman's rubber gloves. Use the leather gloves when.
