Ensure cable fill does not exceed 40% of tray capacity to prevent overheating and maintain ampacity.

Installation Steps Mark the tray path using a laser level or chalk line along walls or ceilings. Fix supports with metal plugs, mounting brackets, base plates, and nuts, ensuring proper alignment. Cut and assemble trays to required lengths, following manufacturer instructions. Lay cables carefully, securing them with cable ties that are snug but not overly tight. Check grounding and bonding connections to meet safety standards.
