Installation procedures, including proper support, alignment, and securing of trays. Maintenance and system modifications, ensuring long-term reliability and safety. Safety warnings, such as prohibiting the use of cable trays as walkways or ladders, and highlighting the risk of hazardous voltages. The guidelines are designed to accommodate both metallic and nonmetallic cable tray systems and are periodically reviewed to reflect advances in technology and construction techniques. Compliance and References NEC Article 392: Ensures electrical code compliance for cable tray installations. NEMA VE 1 and NEMA FG 1: Provide additional design and fabrication standards for cable trays. NFPA 70E: Specifies safe electrical work practices to protect personnel during installation and maintenance. Key Recommendations Only qualified personnel should perform installation and maintenance. Follow proper support spacing, load ratings, and alignment to maintain system performance. Regularly inspect and maintain cable trays to prevent damage or hazards.
