

Cable tray elbow dimensions and parameters

Cable tray elbows must have a minimum bend radius of 12 to 48 inches depending on tray size, with a tangent length of at least 3 inches to ensure proper cable routing and compliance with standards.

Tangent Length: All elbows must include a tangent section of at least 3 inches before the curve begins. This tangent ensures smooth cable entry and reduces stress on the cables during installation.

Rung and Side Rail Considerations: For ladder-type trays, rungs should have a minimum cable bearing surface of 7/8 inch with radiused edges, and no part of the rung should protrude below the side rails. Each rung must support the cable load with a safety factor of 1.5 and withstand a 200 lb concentrated load when tested according to NEMA VE 1 standards.

Tray Widths and Depths: Elbow specifications are compatible with standard tray widths of 6, 9, 12, 18, 24, 30, and 36 inches and depths of 3 to 6 inches minimum usable load depth, ensuring that elbows match the straight sections of the tray system.

Material and Finish: Elbows are manufactured from materials consistent with the straight tray sections, including galvanized steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, and must meet ASTM and NEMA standards for structural integrity and corrosion resistance.

Practical Considerations

Cable Fill Compliance: Ensure that the elbow radius is sufficient for the largest cable diameter in the tray to avoid exceeding the maximum allowable bend radius for the cable type.

Installation: Maintain proper support spacing near elbows to prevent sagging or excessive stress on cables.
