- Composite and FRP trays:** Fiber-reinforced plastics and steel-plastic composites offer impermeability, but joints must be carefully sealed to prevent water ingress.
- Surface Treatments** Surface treatments enhance durability and corrosion resistance:

 - Hot-dip galvanization:** Immersing trays in molten zinc forms a robust zinc-iron alloy coating.
 - Electro-galvanization:** Deposits a thin zinc layer for moderate corrosion protection.
 - Painting and powder coating:** Epoxy or polyurethane coatings provide chemical resistance, weather protection, and aesthetic customization.
