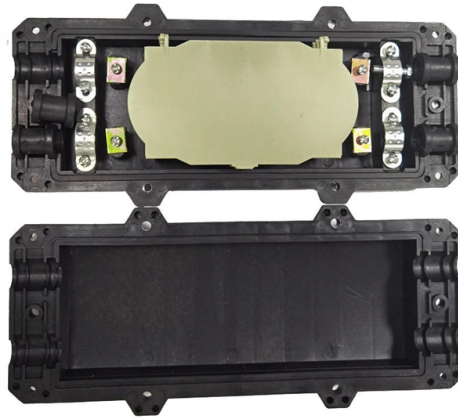


Cable tray side connecting pipe

When connecting a pipe to the side of a cable tray, proper spacing, support, and protection measures are essential to ensure safety and prevent interference. Installation Considerations When a pipe is connected or routed alongside a cable tray, it is important to maintain adequate safety distances to prevent heat, vibration, or chemical damage to the cables. Pipes carrying corrosive liquids or gases should not be installed directly above or below cable trays; if unavoidable, a minimum distance of 500 mm is recommended, along with corrosion-resistant covers or partitions to protect the cables (Gittewire) . For thermal pipelines, the distance should be at least 500 mm with insulation and 1000 mm without insulation, with additional thermal protection at intersections .Structural and Support Guidelines Cable trays and side-connected pipes should be installed in coordination with the building structure, such as walls, beams, or columns, to ensure stability. Pipes should ideally be arranged on one side of the cable tray to avoid interference and allow easy maintenance (Gittewire) . Supports for both the tray and the pipe must be designed to handle the combined weight and prevent sagging or misalignment. Protection and Routing Corrosion protection: Use corrosion-resistant covers or partitions when pipes carry corrosive substances near cable trays .Thermal protection: Install thermal insulation boards at intersections with hot pipelines to prevent heat damage to cables .Wall penetrations: When pipes and trays pass through walls, use appropriate sealing devices for fireproof or explosion-proof areas, and rainproof measures for outdoor transitions .Cable Tray Types and Accessories Side connections may involve T-pieces, elbows, or branch fittings to route pipes or conduits alongside the tray. Ventilated, solid, or wire-mesh trays can be selected based on environmental conditions, load requirements, and the need for electromagnetic interference protection (ABB Technical Guide) .
