

Cascaded PoE Switches



AI Overview

Cascading PoE switches allows multiple switches to be connected to expand network ports and extend PoE power delivery, but careful planning is required to avoid bandwidth bottlenecks and device damage. What is Switch Cascading? Switch cascading is the process of connecting multiple switches via physical links to expand the network size and increase the number of available ports. Each switch in a cascade operates independently, and data can flow freely between devices across the cascaded switches, forming a logical network unit. Cascading is cost-effective and simple to deploy, making it suitable for small to medium-sized networks. Types of Cascading for PoE Switches

- Uplink Port Cascading** Uses a dedicated uplink port on one switch to connect to another switch. Requires a straight-through Ethernet cable, with each cable segment not exceeding 100 meters. Typically supports up to 5 levels of cascaded switches. The upper switch can provide PoE to downstream devices if it has sufficient power capacity.
- Normal Port Cascading** Connects standard Ethernet ports between switches. Requires a crossover cable or proper pin configuration (jumping pins 1-3 and 2-6). Can be used when uplink ports are unavailable, but careful attention is needed to avoid network loops.

Considerations for PoE Cascading

- Power Budget:** Each PoE switch has a maximum power output. Cascading multiple PoE switches can strain the power budget if many devices require power simultaneously. Standard PoE chip switches can detect powered devices and supply power safely, while non-standard PoE switches may risk device damage if misconnected.
- Bandwidth Limitations:** Cascading increases the number of devices but can create bottlenecks if the uplink or cascade link does not have sufficient bandwidth to handle aggregated traffic.
- Device Compatibility:** Standard PoE switches can safely cascade to other PoE or non-PoE switches, but microcontroller-based or non-standard PoE switches should not connect PoE ports in series to non-powered devices.
