

Check if the optical port of the switch is open

- Check Module Recognition: Run `show inventory` to confirm the switch detects the SFP module (part number, serial number, and vendor). If the module is unsupported or err-disabled, follow vendor guidance to enable it or replace it with a certified module.
- Optional Troubleshooting: If the port does not come up: Re-seat the optical module. Verify fiber connections and patch cords. Use an optical power meter to measure received power. Check remote port configuration and auto-negotiation settings.
- For persistent issues, consider rebooting the switch or updating firmware.
