

Company Distribution Box Installation Requirements Standards

Site Selection and Placement The distribution box should be installed close to the power supply to minimize power loss and ensure safety. - Fiberglass (FRP):** strong, good insulation, resistant to harsh conditions.

Check the IP or NEMA rating to ensure protection against dust and water ingress, especially for outdoor or industrial applications.

Wiring and Electrical Connections

- Power Off:** Ensure the power supply is completely disconnected before starting installation.
- Wire Selection:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching the load current. Avoid undersized wires to prevent overheating.
- Circuit Breakers:** Install independent breakers for each circuit according to load requirements.
- Termination:** Connect line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following color coding standards. Ensure tight connections and proper insulation.
- Cable Management:** Route wires neatly, secure with cable ties, an...
