The most immediate and noticeable consequence of cutting a fiber optic line is the loss of connectivity. Fiber optic cables are used to transmit data over long distances with minimal loss, and cutting the line disrupts this transmission. This damage immediately blocks the transmission of data, voice, and video, leading to a loss of connectivity or severe service degradation for. The most common reason for interrupted fiber optic service is fiber optic cable cuts. It's not uncommon to have a fiber go down, and before you can locate the fault, have the crew who did it. Unearthing damaged fiber doesn't have to be a pain.
