For mixed cable types, maintain separation between power and data cables to reduce electromagnetic interference. Label cables clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting.

Compliance and Safety Ensure all cables are tray-rated and code-compliant, and metallic trays are properly grounded and bonded. When passing through fire-rated walls or floors, use appropriate firestop systems to prevent fire spread. Follow NEC Article 392 and local electrical codes for tray fill, gr...
