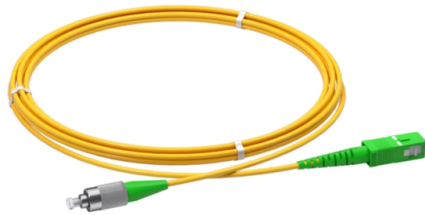

- Transformers:** Convert incoming voltage to levels suitable for PDUs and IT equipment, typically stepping down from 480V three-phase to 208V/120V.
- Monitoring Tools:** Enable real-time tracking of voltage, current, and power consumption, helping prevent failures and optimize energy usage.
- Redundancy Features:** PDPs often include dual feeds or mirrored panels to maintain power during maintenance or equipment failure.

PDP vs PDU vs PDC

- PDP (Power Distribution Panel):** Centralized distribution point feeding multiple PDUs; manages high-level power routing and protection.
- PDU (Power Distribution Unit):** Rack-level distribution device delivering power to servers and networking equipment; may include metering and outlet control.
- PDC (Power Distribution Centre):** Larger-scale unit that distributes power to multiple PDPs or PDUs; includes transformers, breakers, and monitoring for the entire data center.
