- Height and Positioning:** Standard installation height is approximately 1.5m from the floor; distribution boards may require 1.8m. Heights can be adjusted for operational convenience with design approval.
- Level and Stable Mounting:** Ensure vertical deviation is within 1.5mm for boxes under 50cm and 3mm for taller boxes. Cable entry holes must be smooth, insulated, and secure.
- Wiring Standards:** Follow color codes for three-phase systems (Phase A: Yellow, Phase B: Green, Phase C: Red, Neutral: Light Blue, Protective Earth: Yellow/Green bi-color). Maintain neat, horizontal/vertical wiring with proper bending radius and bundling.
- Grounding and Earthing:** Secure connections with spring wash...
