Punching & Drilling: Holes for circuit breakers, switches, cable entries, and mounting hardware are created using specialized punching machines to ensure precise alignment ().

Welding & Assembly: Metal parts are spot-welded or fastened, with reinforcements added at stress points. Plastic enclosures may use snap-fit or screw assemblies ().

Surface Finishing: Metal housings are treated with phosphate coating or powder coating for corrosion resistance and durability. Standard colors often include safety grey ().

Sealing and Protection To ensure IP or NEMA protection, housings are sealed using polyurethane or silicone foams applied via FIPFG (Formed-In-Place Foam Gasket) technology. This creates a precise, resilient gasket that protects electronics from moisture, dust, and extreme weather. High-quality foams allow repeated opening and closing without compromising the seal ().
