Durability: Labels should be resistant to heat, oil, UV, and moisture, as recommended by IEC 61439 for distribution boards. Use materials that adhere well to metal or plastic surfaces and remain legible over time. Placement: Position labels near the corresponding breaker or component, ideally at eye level or in a location that is easily visible during maintenance. Arrange incoming breakers on top, outgoing feeders at the bottom, and controls in the middle for clarity. Practical Recommendation Small distribution boxes: 2" x 3" label for each breaker or section.
