Basic Wiring Layout

Main Supply Connection: The incoming phase and neutral lines from the energy meter are connected to the main isolator or main MCB. This acts as the primary switch for the entire distribution box, allowing manual disconnection of power for maintenance or emergencies.

RCCB Connection: From the main MCB, the phase line is routed to the RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker), which protects against leakage currents and electric shocks. The neutral line is also connected to the RCCB input. The RCCB output then feeds the individual MCBs.

MCB Connections: Each Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB) receives power from the RCCB output. Single-pole MCBs are typically used for standard loads, while double-pole MCBs may be used for special or high-power loads. The MCBs distribute electricity to separate circuits in the building.

Neutral and Ground Arrangement: All neutral wires from the circuits are connected to a neutral busbar, while all ground wires are connected to a ground busbar. Proper grounding ensures safety and prevents electrical hazards.

Wire Numbering and Box Fill

Counting Wires: According to NEC standards, each conductor entering the box counts as one wire. Wires running through without splicing count as one, and all ground wires together count as a single conductor.

Device Connections: Each wire connecting to a device (MCB, switch, or outlet) counts as one wire. If a device is mounted on a strap, add two more conductors for the strap.

Box Fill Calculation: The total number of conductors, including wires, clamps, and devices, determines the minimum box size required to avoid overcrowding and ensure safe operation.
