Branch Circuits Branch circuits are the individual outgoing circuits fed from the distribution box. Each branch circuit typically includes: Circuit breakers or fuses to protect against overloads and short circuits. Residual current devices (RCDs) or RCBOs for leakage protection. Busbars to distribute power efficiently to multiple breakers . Neutral and earth bars for proper grounding and safety . Branch circuits allow segmentation of loads, making maintenance easier and improving safety by isolating faults without affecting the entire system.
