Form Factor: HBA cards are full-sized PCIe cards, whereas SFP modules are small, pluggable units inserted into HBA or switch ports . Location: HBA cards are installed inside servers; SFP modules are inserted into the HBA or switch ports . Summary While HBA cards often use optical modules to connect to fiber networks, the HBA itself is not an optical module. It is a host adapter that provides the interface and processing for storage communication, and the optical module is a separate component that enables fiber optic connectivity .
