Enable high-density port organization in racks, cassettes, or wall enclosures. Allow easy upgrades or reconfiguration without disturbing the main fiber infrastructure. Best Practices Use dust caps or shutters to prevent contamination when connectors are not in use. Maintain minimum bend radius to avoid fiber damage and signal loss.
