

Drill holes in the cover plate of the distribution box for sealing



Overview

Twist drills grab in thin material and drill three-lobed holes and can distort the material where you want it to be flat at the seal. 20mm is a bit small for a Greenlee style punch. Even a cheap one is better than. They typically call for holes close in size to the 20mm dimension rather than the machinist's M20 clearance hole of 21mm (tight) or 22mm (nominal). The hole itself is a clearance hole for an M20 threaded body rather than a tapped hole: I suggest a decent quality metric step drill. The main function of the explosion-proof distribution box is to ensure the normal operation of electrical equipment in flammable and explosive environments and to prevent explosion accidents caused by electrical sparks. Gaskets deteriorate over time and are subject to misinstallation. It is not truly water tight so anything. Fix the outdoor junction box using expansion bolts fitted with rubber sealing washers. Pierce the pre-molded knockout holes at the bottom edge for cable entry points.
