

Drilling holes for tunnel cable tray supports

Holes for cable tray supports should be drilled slightly larger than the fastener diameter to allow adjustment and prevent thread damage. Hole Sizing and Placement When installing cable tray supports in tunnels, holes in cross members or support brackets should be 1/16" to 1/8" larger than the diameter of the threaded rod or all-thread to allow easy adjustment and prevent thread damage during installation (Unitray Installation Guide). Ensure that the cross member length accommodates tray clips and allows horizontal adjustment of the tray. The shorter the vertical rod, the less horizontal adjustment is possible, so plan rod lengths accordingly. Drilling and Edge Treatment Drill holes cleanly to avoid burrs that could damage cable insulation. After cutting or drilling, bevel sharp edges and treat exposed metal with zinc-rich paint to prevent corrosion (Paktechpoint Method Statement). Avoid drilling through perforations in the tray; drill along solid metal lines for structural integrity. Support Installation Position clamps around the ladder tray siderails and insert the threaded rod through the drilled holes. Use washers and hex nuts to secure the tray, ensuring the cross member is level and snug. Maximum support spacing is typically 3.6 meters, with a load capacity per hanger of 318-340 kg (Unitray Installation Guide). Fabricated supports should be dedicated to cable trays and not attached to process piping, maintaining a minimum distance of 300 mm from parallel pipes (Paktechpoint Method Statement). Material and Standards Use steel or stainless steel supports with appropriate galvanization for corrosion protection (OBO CMS Guide). Follow relevant standards such as NEMA and DIN EN 61537 for cable support systems to ensure mechanical strength, safety, and compliance (OBO CMS Guide).
