 - Mechanical Splicing:** Uses an alignment fixture and index-matching gel to join fibers temporarily. It is commonly used for multimode fibers or emergency repairs.
- Connectorization**
 - Connectors:** Attach a fiber to equipment or patch panels, allowing temporary or removable connections. Common types include ST, SC, LC, MU, E2000, and MT connectors, each with specific ferrule sizes and applications.
 - Ferrules:** Precision ceramic or metal components that align the fiber within the connector to minimize signal loss.
 - Pigtails:** Pre-terminated short fiber segments used for splicing to field-installed fibers, especially for singlemode terminations.
- Hybrid Optical-Electric Cable Termination**
 - For hybrid cables containing both optical fibers and power conductors, specialized termination assemblies are used. These include:
 - Optical fiber termination:** A butting tube and tube fitting to align the fiber with the receiving tube.
 - Power cable termination:** Insulation sheath and metal connection piece for electrical conductors.
 - Sealing caps:** Glove-type cold or thermal shrink caps that hermetically seal both optical and power terminations, preventing dust and moisture.
