Fiber optic cable is surprisingly strong, durable and pliable; however, several best practices should be followed to ensure a successful cable installation. Most fiber optic cables boast a pull strength of 100 – 200. Fiber optic cables have Kevlar aramid yarn or a fiberglass rod as their strength member. NOTE: The below considerations are not intended to encompass all installation practices.
