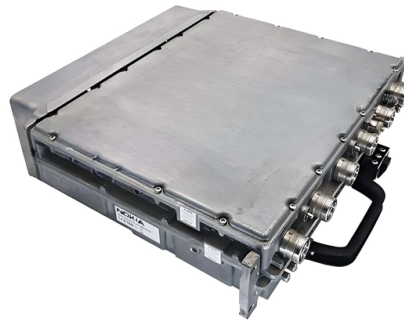

- 5. Cable Protection** For outdoor or exposed installations, protect the cable at corners with ducts, innerducts, or protective sleeves to prevent abrasion or crushing. Ensure that armored cables crossing each other are properly supported to avoid high-pressure points ().
- 6. Planning and Documentation** Conduct a site survey to identify all corners and potential hazards. Develop a cable pulling plan that specifies corner locations, bend radii, and intermediate access points. Document the installation for future maintenance ().
