Using a conduit through the roof adds extra protection against moisture and physical damage (SoftHandTech) .Securing and Routing Inside the building, secure the cable with soft Velcro ties rather than plastic zip ties to prevent crushing. Avoid sharp bends and maintain gentle curves to prevent microbends or macrobends that can degrade signal quality.
