Some routers support direct fiber connections via SFP or WAN ports labeled for fiber, allowing fiber-to-the-desktop (FTTD) setups without converting to copper Ethernet. Fiber switches and network adapters can also connect multiple fiber lines or convert between single-mode and multi-mode fiber, maintaining high-speed connectivity and electrical isolation.
