

Fiber optic connection to switch and multiple routers

Fiber optic connections require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert light signals into Ethernet, which then connects to your router or switch for network distribution.

Key Components

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Converts incoming fiber optic light signals into electrical signals compatible with standard networking equipment. Typically provided by your ISP and installed near the fiber entry point in your home or office.
- Fiber-Ready Router or Switch:** Devices that support high-speed Ethernet connections. Some enterprise-grade switches may have SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) ports for direct fiber connections.

Connection Steps

- Install the ONT:** Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical input port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network.
- Connect ONT to Router or Switch:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN or Ethernet output port to the WAN port of your router or to an uplink port on a switch. For switches with SFP ports, you can use a compatible fiber transceiver module to connect directly to the fiber line if supported.
- Power and Configure Devices:** Power on the router or switch after the ONT is active. Configure the router for your network settings, including IP addressing, VLANs, or QoS if needed. Ensure the switch ports are properly configured to handle the incoming traffic from the ONT or router.
- Verify Connectivity:** Check the ONT and router/switch status lights to confirm a stable connection. Test network speed and latency to ensure the fiber connection is performing as expected.

Additional Considerations:
