- Multi-mode (MM: OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5):** Wider core ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) for short-distance links, suitable for intra-data center connections and LANs. Color-coded by standard: OM1/OM2 = orange, OM3/OM4 = aqua, OM5 = lime green or violet.

Connector Types

- Common connectors include:**
- LC:** Small form factor, duplex, widely used in modern data centers, compatible with QSFP transceivers.
- MPO/MTP:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications.
- SC, ST, FC:** Traditional connectors for telecom and enterprise networks.

Jacket Types

- PVC:** Standard indoor use.
- Plenum (OFNP):** Fire-resistant, suitable for air ducts.
- Riser (OFNR):** For vertical shafts between floors.
- LSZH:** Low smoke, zero halogen, common in Europe and high-safety areas.
