Overview

Begin fiber optic cable troubleshooting by inspecting fiber patch cables, connectors, and ports for visible damage. Unlike backbone cables, patch cords are frequently connected, disconnected, bent, and handled by technicians, making them the most vulnerable. Even a dust cover designed to protect the fiber endface can be a significant source of contamination. The most common problems usually fall into four categories: Physical Layer: Transmission Performance: Equipment and Module Failures:. While dust caps are great at preventing damage to the endface, the plastic used to create dust caps can emit a residue as it deteriorates over time and the surface of the cap may contain mold-release substances used in high-speed production processes. Yet in practice, one tiny particle of dust can cause major performance issues —increasing insertion loss, degrading return loss, or even completely blocking the signal.
