Port Density by Panel Type

High-Density Data Center Panels: Cisco high-density panels can support 72 LC duplex ports in 1RU, 144 in 2RU, and 216 in 3RU, enabling efficient management of 10G to 400G breakout requirements.

Floor-standing Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs) can scale from 72 to 720 ports for central offices or hyperscale data centers.

Connector Types and Configurations

- LC Duplex: Most common for high-density applications, supporting 2 fibers per port.
- SC, FC, ST: Available in lower-density or legacy deployments.
- MPO/MTP: Used for backbone or high-speed aggregation, often in modular cassettes for breakout to LC or CS connectors.
