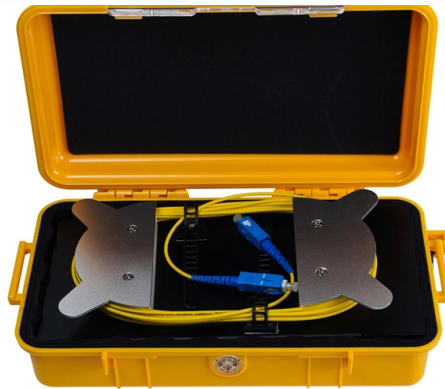


Fiber optic single-mode dual-mode and single-fiber dual-fiber

This makes it easier to couple light from LEDs or VCSELs and reduces equipment costs. However, modal dispersion limits the effective transmission distance, making multimode fiber ideal for short-range applications such as within buildings, data centers, or campus networks. Multimode fibers are classified into types like OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5, with higher OM numbers supporting higher bandwidth and longer distances.
