

Fireproofing and Sealing Openings in Vertical Shaft Cable Trays

Firestopping Requirements When cable trays pass through vertical shafts, walls, or slabs, all openings must be tightly sealed with firestopping materials to maintain the integrity of fire-rated barriers. Common materials include fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, and fire-resistant mineral wool. For large openings, a fire-resistant backing plate should be installed before sealing. Gaps between firestop packs and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and packing thickness should be at least 24 cm. All gaps inside and around metal trunking must be sealed both internally and externally, and cover plates should be square, evenly painted, and properly fitted.

Fireproof Cable Tray Materials Cable trays used in vertical shafts should be fire-resistant. Options include galvanized steel, stainless steel, fire-resistant coated trays, and flame-retardant plastic composites. Surfaces can be coated with fire-retardant paint to slow flame spread and increase heat resistance. Fire barriers can be installed within trays to isolate different fire zones, ensuring that flames do not propagate along the tray.

Installation and Sealing Techniques

Firestop Packs and Putty: UL-listed systems, such as 3M firestop pillows or moldable putty, can be used to seal openings around cable trays. The number of pillows depends on tray size, and putty sticks are applied to ensure complete coverage.

Slab Penetrations: At floor or slab penetrations, provide 20–30 mm of firestopping and install a fire-support plate at the top. Waterstops of at least 50 mm height are recommended at floor level.

Sequence: Firestopping is typically performed after cable routing, grounding, and waterproofing steps to ensure proper installatio...
