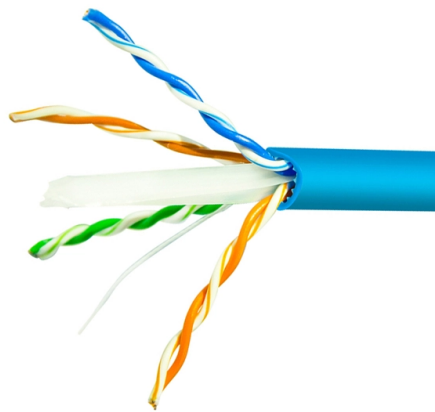


Fixing Method of Vertical Shaft Cable Tray Cover Plate

Ensure the cover does not obstruct cable access points or interfere with maintenance operations.
