

Forced 100Mbps speed for optical modules

- Port Configuration:** Some switches allow you to disable auto-negotiation and force the port to 100Mbps full-duplex. This ensures the module operates at the desired speed without falling back to 10Mbps or attempting higher speeds.
- Industrial Modules:** For harsh environments, industrial-grade modules like OSDSFP100 or FS 100M SFPs provide stable operation at 100Mbps and support diagnostic features like DDM/DOM for monitoring optical conditions.
- EEPROM and Vendor Lock:** Certain modules may require EEPROM encoding to match the host device. Compatible modules like Hirschmann SFPs are pre-encoded to work seamlessly at 100Mbps.

- Access the switch/router interface and set the port speed to 100Mbps, disabling...
