- Protective Enclosure:** Houses all components, preventing accidental contact with live parts. Enclosures are made from steel or reinforced plastic and meet IP/NEMA ratings for environmental protection.
- DIN Rails and Terminal Blocks:** Facilitate mounting of additional devices and neat cable management.

Types of Distribution Boxes

- Residential:** Single-phase, 6–24 circuits, standard breakers for lighting, outlets, and appliances.
- Commercial:** Three-phase, higher current ratings, specialized breakers for elevators, HVAC, and industrial machinery.
- Industrial/Outdoor:** Enhanced protection, multiple voltage levels, motor protection devices, power factor correction, remote monitoring, and weather-resista...
