Warning signs or brightly colored spherical markers, sometimes red or orange, are affixed to the lines near airports or across valleys to make the conductors visible to aircraft, but these are not insulation colors. However, these trays are not immune to safety hazards that could cause system failures, fires, or other catastrophic events.
