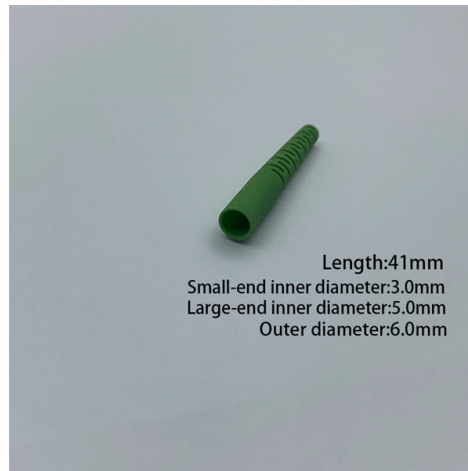


Home Gigabit Fiber Optic Disk Array

Overview A disk array is a collection of hard drives or SSDs configured to work together, often in a RAID (Redundant Array of Independent Disks) setup, to improve performance, reliability, and storage capacity. When connected via fiber optic technology, these arrays can achieve gigabit or higher speeds, making them suitable for demanding applications like media editing, virtualization, or large-scale backups.

Home SAN vs NASSAN (Storage Area Network): Shares storage at the block level, allowing servers to access disks directly via protocols like Fibre Channel. This reduces overhead from file system conversions and improves throughput.

NAS (Network Attached Storage): Shares storage at the file system level using protocols like CIFS/SMB or NFS. Easier to set up but generally slower due to protocol overhead.

For a home setup, a SAN with Fibre Channel can provide superior performance, especially when paired with a RAID controller and multiple drives.

Building a Home Gigabit Fiber Optic Disk Array

Hardware Requirements: Server or NAS chassis with multiple drive bays (e.g., 8–12 bays) RAID controller supporting RAID 5 or RAID 6 for redundancy Fibre Channel Host Bus Adapter (HBA) for connecting to the network High-speed Xeon or equivalent CPU and at least 8GB RAM for handling data throughput Gigabit or higher fiber optic cabling for connectivity

Software Options: Openfiler: Linux-based solution supporting SAN and NAS, compatible with Fibre Channel HBAs Other SAN management software may include FreeNAS/TrueNAS with iSCSI support for block-level access

Configuration Tips: Use RAID 5 or 6 for a balance of performance and fault tolerance Assign LUNs (Logical Unit Numbers) to segment storage for different servers or applications Consider hot-swappable drives for easy maintenance and upgrades
