Mounting and Positioning For rear installation, the distribution box should be affixed securely to the wall using expansion bolts or screws, depending on the wall material. The bolt length should account for the wall depth, box base thickness, and washer/nut thickness, with an extra 5 mm for clearance. For smaller boxes, wooden blocks can be pre-installed at the corners to facilitate mounting with wood screws. If embedding the box in the wall, the cutout should be about 20 mm larger than the box dimensions, and the depth should match the box plus any plastering. Ensure the box is level and plumb, with vertical deviation not exceeding 3 mm, and apply anti-corrosive paint where the box contacts the wall structure.

Enclosure Selection Choose an enclosure based on indoor/outdoor placement and environmental conditions. For indoor use, plastic or steel enclosures are suitable, while outdoor installations require higher protection levels such as IP66 or NEMA 4 to resist water, dust, and corrosion. Ensure the box is installed in a dry, ventilated area, away from flammable, explosive, or corrosive substances, and leave sufficient space around it for maintenance.

Wiring and Safety Inside the box, organize wiring neatly and connect circuits to their respective breakers. Neutral (N) and protective earth (PE) lines should have separate bus bars. Screw fuses should connect to intermediate contact terminals, and porcelain fuses must be installed vertically to prevent electric shock during replacement. Label all circuits clearly, and ensure proper grounding and insulation. Use wires of correct gauge and breakers rated for each circuit.
