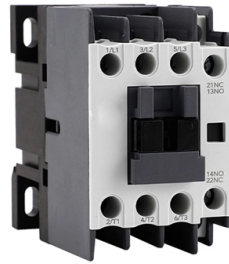


How many units does a cable management rack occupy
