Per-rack: \$1,400–\$2,800 materials + \$1,100–\$2,200 labor. Assumptions: one rack per quote, standard 120V/15A or 208V/30A circuits where applicable. Buyers typically pay based on rack size, materials, cooling needs, and added components. Entry-level racks, such as small wall-mounted units, typically range from \$200 to \$500. These solutions involve adding plastic panels or doors to the rear of the racks, enclosing the hot aisle. Rack-based systems are relatively simple to install. The AisleLok® Modular Wall is a free-standing aluminum framed modular wall structure available with 4mm clear twinwall polycarbonate panels. The SF001-PR2 supports switches with rear-to-front.
