Ensure the received power is within the module's specified sensitivity range. Check Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM) values if supported, including temperature, voltage, bias current, and RX/TX power. Abnormal readings may indicate aging, misalignment, or a failing module. Low TX power or RX alarms after cleaning and reseating often suggest the module or fiber link is failing and may need replacement.
