

How to connect an indoor fiber optic router

Plug in the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to your ISP's network.

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN/Internet port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to set up Wi-Fi, security, and optional Quality of Service (QoS) settings for optimal performance.

Step 4: Optimize Placement and Performance

Place the router centrally for better Wi-Fi coverage. Keep both ONT and router away from moisture, heat, and direct sunlight. Use surge protectors to safeguard equipment. For critical devices, consider wired Ethernet connections to maximize speed and reduce latency.

Step 5: Verify and Troubleshoot

Check ONT lights: Power should be solid green, and data indicators should show activity. Test internet speed and connectivity...
