

How to connect the front panel with the fiber optic box



Overview

First, connect each pre-terminated fiber optic cable to the adapter panel separately, making sure the ports correspond one-to-one; then fix the fiber optic adapter panel to the front panel of the distribution box with the bend radius control clip. There are two spools in the box to manage the optical fibers in the box. In the above figure, the important components of the optical fiber distribution box are marked with serial numbers, and each serial.
