Gently tug on the wire to verify it is secure. Avoid over-tightening, which can damage the wire or terminal ().

Step 5: Organize and Label Use markers or labels to identify each connection for easier troubleshooting and maintenance. Ensure that wires are neatly routed to prevent accidental contact or short circuits.
