

How to handle welding distribution boxes

Joint Design and Alignment Butt edges tightly for sheet metal under 1/8 inch; beveling is generally unnecessary. Ensure all corners and seams are square and aligned using magnetic squares or clamps. For thicker sections, consider multi-pass welding and appropriate joint designs like bevels or grooves.

Quality and Safety Considerations Inspect welds for uniformity, smoothness, and absence of defects such as porosity, cracks, or undercut. Ensure internal edges are smooth and burr-free to prevent damage to internal components. For outdoor applications, select corrosion-
