

How to install a fiber optic router for your telecom provider

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. For larger homes, consider adding mesh Wi-Fi devices to extend coverage.

Step 4: Configure Your Router Access the router's web interface or app to set up Wi-Fi SSID, password, and security settings. Update the router firmware to the latest version for optimal performance. Configure additional settings if needed, such as VLANs, QoS, or parental controls for business or advanced home networks.

Step 5: Test the Connection Verify that all devices can connect to the internet. Check speed and latency to ensure the fiber connection is performing as expected. Adjust router placement for optimal Wi-Fi coverage and minimal interference.
