

How to install and debug a core switch

Installing and debugging a core switch involves proper hardware setup, software configuration, connectivity testing, and using debugging tools like CLI, Device Manager, or JTAG interfaces.

Installation Steps

If the switch fails to boot or software is corrupted, follow the software recovery procedures, which may include reloading the IOS image or restoring from backup.
- CLI and Device Manager Tools** Use the command-line interface (CLI) to inspect logs, interface status, and routing tables. Device Manager or Network Assistant can provide a graphical overview of switch health and connectivity.
- Multi-Core or Embedded Debugging** (if applicable) For switches with multi-core processors, debugging may involve JTAG or TRACE32 interfaces to monitor each core. Connect the debugger with the target powered off, then power on the switch and debugger. Use start-up scripts to initialize debugging sessions and monitor core activity. Multi-core debugging may require separate instances for each core or a single device solution depending on the debugger license.
- Firmware and Module Updates** Ensure firmware is up to date to prevent software bugs. For modular switches, verify that all line cards and modules are recognized and functioning.
- Logging and Monitoring** Enable syslog and SNMP...
